SUPPLIES RECOMMENDED FOR FIRST GRADE

(revised 3-2017)

We have found the following items to be useful to our students during the year in first grade:

- A hard plastic pencil box (with your child's name on it)
- 1 box of crayons (24 count)
- 4 glue sticks
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 24 sharpened pencils to be collected (since pencils are collected there is no need for fancy pencils)
- 2 pink erasers
- 8 dry erase markers (skinny, black only)
- 1 box markers (skinny 8 count)
- 1 box of colored pencils (12 count)
- 2 yellow highlighters
- 2 red pens
- 2 blue pens
- 1 pkg. "Lysol" wipes only
- 1 roll of paper towels (last name A-M)
- 1 box of Ziploc quart size slider top baggies (A-M)
- 1 box of Ziploc gallon size slider top baggies (last name N-Z)

Please send crayons that will fit inside the pencil box – the large sets are too big for the desks.

No pens, please

Most items will be collected and stored in the teacher's closet until needed. Therefore, it is not necessary to label items with your child's name.
