

Happy fall! This is a reminder about a few important events for the end of October.

During the week of October 22nd, we will be celebrating Red Ribbon Week. Each day, there will be an opportunity for your child to participate. Here is the schedule.

Please plan your child's costume keeping in mind that it should be appropriate for school. **Costumes should not be violent, revealing or include weapons. In addition, masks that completely cover the face are not permitted because of safety issues.**

After our last lunch is served, students will begin to prepare for the parade. We encourage you to make sure that your child's costume fits over the clothes that they wear to school. Room parents will assist in setting up the classroom for any parties, but if you would like to assist teachers in helping with costumes, please contact your child's teacher. **Students will not be permitted to go home to change into their costumes.**

The line up in the playground for the parade will begin at 1:40 p.m. **The parade will begin promptly at 1:50 p.m.** This allows parents who also have children at Haviland Avenue School to attend their parade which begins at approximately 1:00 p.m. The parade route will travel the entire school block and the students will return and enter back into the school for their parties. The parties will end at 2:50 p.m. in time for clean up and dismissal.
